- To have my photos critiqued / to learn

The goods and bads of sharing with the public.

The Goods

- Exposure: Get more people to see your photography.
- Easier to do.
- Make money.

The Bads

- There are bad guys (and gals) out there.
- Posting images of people w/out model release can get you in trouble.
 - (There are probably other subject matter that can get you in trouble, I suggest you check with an attorney).
- Your images may be stolen
 - Might be good, might be bad (A stolen image with your watermark and website address could drive people to your website).


What do you need to consider if you do not wish the public to see your photography.

- Password protected websites
- Password protected galleries
- Secret web addresses / URLs

What do you need to consider if you post images for the public to see your photography.

- Post lower resolution images if protection is not enabled
- Use Watermarks (copyright information on the image)
- Model releases (On file of people images you post)







Example Secret URLs / web addresses

You set up a gallery and receive a complicated URL.

You send the URL to people who you wish to see your gallery.

Those people may send this url to others to also see this gallery.

More about DropBox



Dropbox appears to be a folder on your computer.

Anything you place in this folder is copied into the cloud.

You can share this folder two ways

- Share link: Send a link to the folder (no need to be a Dropbox user)
- Share folder: Invite users to have access of the folder (need to be a Dropbox user)
 - After sharing a folder everyone sees the same files. Everyone can add or subtract files inside that folder.

Beware

 Anything you move out or delete will be moved out or deleted from other people's folder.

They fulfill the orders and take care of the of the "Back End"



Posting Images

Posting images to websites are similar (but different).

For sites that do not protect your images (Facebook)

- Consider posting low res JPEG 60% quality
- Size around 800 x 600.
- Watermark with your copyright notice. Include meta data for your copyrights.

For websites that provide commerce (Zenfolio, Smugmug)

Post highest resolution images


Making it easier with Lightroom


The Library module has what is called "Publish Services".


Publish services enables synchronization of catalogs with a website like Facebook, Smugmug, Zenfolio, Dropbox, Flickr, Picasa and Google Drive

Jeffrey Friedl (A photographer in Japan) created a series of Lightroom plugins and has posted them on his website for use. He accepts donations for his work.




