#### The Essentials

- Camera
- Macro lens
- Cable release
- Tripod
- Flash(es)/Lighting
- Softbox

- Tri-fold white foam core board
- White foam core board (for base)
- Vase / Container
- Plamp
- Scissors
- Flower(s)

The Essentials

Camera

 Any camera will do ...dslr, p/s, mirrorless (even film!)

The Essentials

Macro Lens

Not required, but preferred

 Macro lens will allow you to get in close to your subject and fill the frame at minimum working distance

The Essentials

Tripod

- For camera support and stability
- Helps with composition

The Essentials

#### Cable Release

- Eliminates camera shake when pressing shutter release
- Allows flexibility to move around and reposition
- May use self-timer if no cable release

The Essentials

Flash(es)/Lighting

- Natural light from window source
  - Overcast day provides even lighting
- External Flash
- Softbox

The Essentials

White Foam Core Boards

- Tri-fold presentation board
- 20" x30" for base

(Staples, A.C. Moore, other craft or office supply stores)

The Essentials

All the rest ...

- Flower(s)
- Vase/container (different sizes)
- Plamp holds/separates a single flower from the rest
- Scissors trim flower stems to fit

## Settings

 ISO 400, Manual, 1/250<sup>th</sup> @ f/8 and adjust up or down as necessary

 Off camera flash set to TTL and place fairly close at about 45 degree angle to subject

### Composition

- Arrange the flower(s) to your liking and compose image
- Many different compositions possible
  - Single flower or small group
  - Bouquet or part of flower
  - From above or below
  - Include vase vs flowers only

### Processing Images

Open image in PS or Elements

 Plug-in software such as Nik Filters or Topaz, etc to enhance and optimize the image

### **Creative Process**

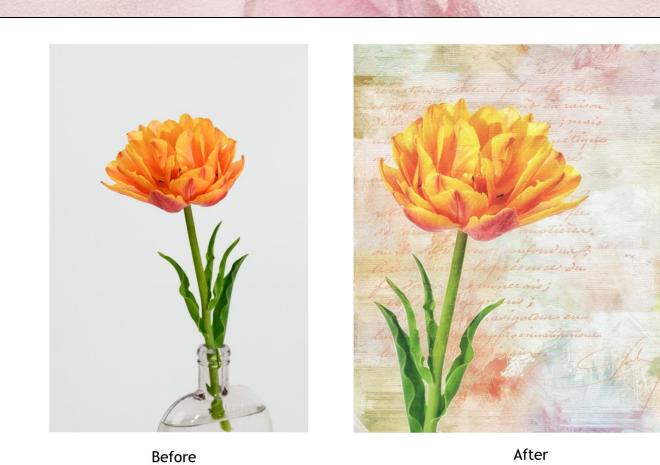
- Add Texture Overlay(s)
